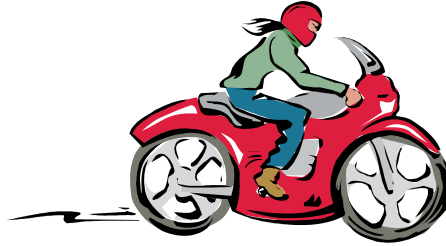




Want to Get Your Motorbike Licence?

Here's what you need to do



If You Already Hold an ACT Licence

You will need to complete a Pre-Learner Rider Training course with Stay Upright to gain the Motorcycle class on your Learner Licence. The course costs \$236.00 and can be booked by phoning (02) 6241 3963. Once you have passed the Stay Upright course you will be given a certificate. You need to bring the certificate along with your ACT Licence to any of the Canberra Connect Shopfronts or the Canberra Connect Driver Licence Service (located in the Civic Library) to be issued a Motorcycle Learner Licence at a cost of \$33.25. You will not be allowed to ride your motorbike on a public road until you have completed the Stay Upright Course and obtained the Motorcycle Licence Class on your licence.

If You Do Not Hold a Current ACT Licence

You will need to complete a Road Ready Course and Road Rules Knowledge Test. The course costs \$146.00 and can be booked by phoning Road Ready on (02) 6162 5152 or (02) 6282 8990. When you have completed the Road Ready Course you will be issued a certificate. You must bring the certificate along with Proof of Identity and Residency to any Canberra Connect Shopfront or the Canberra Connect Driver Licence Service (located in the Civic Library) to be issued your Car Learner Licence. This will cost you \$42.60 which includes a Road Ready Pack.

You will need to complete a Pre-Learner Rider Training Course with Stay Upright to gain the Motorcycle class on your Learner Licence. The course costs \$236.00 and can be booked by phoning (02) 6241 3963.

Once you have passed the Stay Upright Course you will be given a certificate. You need to bring the certificate along with your ACT Learner Licence to any of the Canberra Connect Shopfronts or the Canberra Connect Driver Licence Service (located in the Civic Library) to have the Motorcycle Class added to your Learner Car Licence. This will be added at no fee. You will not be allowed to ride your motorbike on a public road until you have completed the Stay Upright Course and obtained the Motorcycle Licence Class on your licence.

Provisional Motorcycle Licence

You must hold your Learner Motorcycle Licence for at least 3 months and be at least 17 years old before you can get your Provisional Motorcycle Licence.

When you are ready to get your Provisional Licence, you will need to pass an assessment with Stay Upright. The assessment will cost you \$45.00 and can be booked by phoning (02) 6241 3963.

If you pass the assessment you will be given a certificate. Bring this certificate along with your ACT Licence to any of the Canberra Connect Shopfronts or the Canberra Connect Driver Licence Service (located in the Civic Library) to have your licence upgraded. If you hold a Learner Licence the Provisional Licence will cost you \$85.15. If you hold a current Full Licence the Motorcycle Provisional class will be added to your licence at no cost.

If you do not already hold a Full ACT Licence, you will be required to hold your provisional Motorcycle Licence for 3 years. If you hold a Full Licence, you will be required to hold your Provisional Licence for 1 year.
